Departing:

Aircraft keys and flight detail sheet binder are kept behind the front desk and must be dispatched by Signature staff. The staff receives a daily fax from which they'll verify your name and scheduled tail number association. They may be unaware of last minute changes to the schedule. If a discrepancy is found, please be patient while they call us to confirm your booking.

Fuel orders may be called in several hours in advance of your flight, though we recommend not calling the night before in case unexpected circumstances force your cancellation. (The aircraft would then be left topped off for another Owner who may have weight and balance issues to contend with.)

In the event that the regular set of airplane keys are not available, there is an 'emergency' set of spare keys kept behind the counter.

Arriving:

Return the aircraft key and flight binder to the front desk. Please ensure that the Flight Detail Sheet has been properly filled out and then promptly faxed by the customer service rep whenever possible.

If the spare (rather than the regular set of) keys are used for your flight, please return them to Signature staff. They will store them where they normally keep all of their aircraft key sets.

Runway 17L Nighttime Approach

A nighttime approach to either Runway 17L or 22 is considered a "black hole" approach. Both runways thresholds are adjacent to a large body of water. "Black hole" approaches involve optical illusions which compromise the pilot's ability to visually judge proper glideslope. Conditions permitting, using the ILS for guidance is recommended for nighttime Runway 17L approaches.

Mandatory Curfew:

None.

Voluntary Curfew (non-regulatory):

"Quiet Window" between 11:00pm and 6:00am

Noise Abatement:

Centrally located within Florida's most densely populated County, the St. Petersburg-Clearwater International Airport (PIE, Airport) is surrounded by noise-sensitive communities.

The Office of Noise Affairs does monitor compliance with the Voluntary Quiet Window and may contact operators who frequently operate at night to remind them of the program.
